

Caring for your SYNTHETIC PROSTHESES

How to put your wig on: If necessary, secure your own hair by pinning and/or using a wig cap/liner. Hold your wig by its Temple Tabs & slip over your head. Adjust until wig sits at your hairline & temple tabs are aligned with the corner of your eyes.

How to take off your wig: NEVER pull on the lace. Use your temple tabs to lift the wig straight up and off OR grab the back neckline and gently slide the wig off.

IMPORTANT NOTES : Avoid exposure to heat and steam such as blow dryers, curling irons, oven, tea pots, microwave, cooking stoves, fireplaces, or any other direct heat. High heat will damage the fibers and remove the curl. Please see your wig professional to have your wig re-curled, if necessary.

When laying down with your wig on, use a silk or satin pillowcase. This will minimize friction damage to the fibers. It is recommended that you not wear your wig to bed, instead use a wig cap.

The synthetic fibers cannot be colored, toned, etc. Use only recommended products. **On any wig that is shoulder length or longer, every night after wear, turn inside out and pick through the ends to help prevent fraying or tangling of the ends.**

HOW TO WASH YOUR NEW SYNTHETIC PROSTHESES (FRIST TIME 2-3 MONTHS, AFTER FIRST WASH 4-6weeks)

Prep: Gently remove tangles and debris with wide tooth comb, starting with ends and slowly working toward the roots to avoid damage.

Wash & Condition:

1. Fill a basin or your sink with **COLD WATER**. NEVER use hot, warm or lukewarm water
2. Place a quarter size amount of synthetic shampoo "Cleanse" in your hand and lather under cold running water. Be careful not to overfill with water and dilute the effectiveness of the shampoo. You will only need the amount of water that it takes for the hairpiece to lay submerged.
3. Turn wig inside out, submerge in the water, and soak for 5-10 minutes.
DO NOT scrunch or agitate fibers or cap.
4. Take your wig out and lay on a towel. Replace the water with a fresh batch of clean cold water, submerge the wig in repeatedly until totally rinsed. Lay wig on towel and blot dry. **DO NOT squeeze or twist.**
5. Return your wig to it's original right-side out position and mist with synthetic conditioner "Restore" at midshafts to end, avoiding the wig cap (top, lace portion).
6. Place wig on the stand and use your fingers to gently position the fibers into the desired style. Let air dry completely. **Do Not use a pick until totally dry and never use a blow dryer (hot or cold) DO NOT dry in direct sunlight.**
7. When your wig is completely dry shake and proceed to gently pick or finger style your piece.

Caring for your SYNTHETIC TOPPER

How to put your topper on: Delicately tease/compact the sections of hair that will lay directly underneath the clip(s). Hold the topper upside down in front of you with your thumbs on either side of the clip(s) that will lay on top of or slightly behind your hairline. Flip the topper over your head and bring the topper down against your scalp. Secure the front clip(s) by pressing down on the outer edges of the clip. While securing the rest of the clips, remember to hold the topper steady to eliminate any chance of pulling against the previously secured front clip(s).

How to take off your topper: Unclip all of the clips, in no particular order by pressing down on the center of each clip. Give the topper a little wiggle and slowly work to remove each clip at a time by separating the hair out of each clip.

IMPORTANT NOTES: Avoid exposure to heat and steam such as blow dryers, curling irons, oven, tea pots, microwave, cooking stoves, fireplaces, grills/bonfires, or any other direct heat. High heat will damage the fibers and remove the curl.

Please see your hairloss solutions professional to have your topper re-curled, if necessary.

When laying down with your topper on, use a silk or satin pillowcase. This will minimize friction damage to the fibers. It is recommended that you not wear your topper to bed. Be mindful when laying in recliners.

The synthetic fibers cannot be colored, toned, etc. Use only recommended products. **On any topper that is shoulder length or longer, every night after wear, pick through the ends to help prevent fraying or tangling of the ends.**

HOW TO WASH YOUR NEW SYNTHETIC TOPPER (FRIST TIME 2-3 MONTHS / AFTER FIRST WASH 4-6 weeks)

Prep: Gently remove tangles and debris with wide tooth comb, starting with ends and slowly working toward the roots to avoid damage.

Shampoo & Condition:

1. Fill a basin or your sink with COLD WATER. **NEVER use hot, warm or lukewarm water.**
 2. Place a quarter size amount of synthetic shampoo "Cleanse" in your hand and lather under cold running water. Be careful not to overfill with water and dilute the effectiveness of the shampoo. You will only need the amount of water that it takes for the hairpiece to lay submerged.
 3. Submerge the hairpiece in the water. Soak for 5-10 minutes. **DO NOT scrunch or agitate the fibers.**
 4. Take your topper out and lay on a towel. Replace water with a fresh batch of clean cold water and submerge the topper in repeatedly until totally rinsed. Lay topper on towel and blot dry. **DO NOT squeeze or twist.**
 5. Hang dry or lay flat. Mist your topper with synthetic conditioner "Restore" at midshafts to end, avoiding the lace portion of the base as much as possible.
 6. Gently position the fibers into the desired style and detangle with your fingers. Let air dry completely. **DO NOT use a pick until totally dry and never use a blow dryer (hot or cold) / DO NOT dry in direct sunlight.**
1. When your topper is completely dry, you can proceed to gently pick or finger style your piece.

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
